

## **SHARE Presenter - Job Description**

### SHARE PRESENTER

**Objectives of the Position: Represent AWC in the community by delivering quality Sexual Risk Avoidance (SRA) education to high school and middle school students in churches and community programs, as well as building and maintaining relationships with community and church leaders.**

**Reports to:** SHARE Director and Operations Director

**Status:** FLSA Non-Exempt, Part-time; primarily remote, but must be available for on-site team meetings and calls

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Bachelor's degree or a minimum of three years of experience working with pre-teens/teens in related fields such as sexual risk avoidance education, public speaking, teen training programs, teen recreational/group leader, coach, youth group leader, and/or acting
- Experience in collaborating with a variety of personnel in educational or community-based environments, including schools and churches
- Must participate in REAL Essentials training and achieve the SRA Specialist Certification
- Must embody the principles, practices, and values outlined in the curriculum being taught
- Requires flexibility with working hours, including afternoons and evenings.
- The SRA position requires building and developing a program, including establishing contacts, making calls, and conducting follow-ups
- Must be able to lead and command a room of students
- Other skills include, but are not limited to: communication skills, computer skills, reliability, organization, drive to persevere and build, work independently, and initiate and lead projects.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Calling, emailing, and meeting with church staff and potential community leaders to build relationships and present SHARE content
- Schedule presentations and maintain a presentation calendar
- Prepare for presentations, which includes: reviewing curriculum, preparing handouts, and gathering props
- Recording data and IMPACT information
- Present engaging presentations to youth students

## **SCHEDULE**

The schedule and hours worked will depend on the efforts and success in building the program. As presentations are scheduled, the SHARE Presenter can expect to initially work one or two nights each month, but it could be either less or more, and as the program grows, the hours can also grow.
